What's included?

ALL OF THE SERVICES LISTED BELOW ARE INCLUDED IN THE HOLIDAY PRICE

- **Flights:** return flights from London to Kittilä Airport (via Helsinki). Subject to change and availability
- **Transfers:** return group airport bus transfers

Reindeer Sleigh Ride

In Lapland, reindeer-pulled sleighs have been used throughout the centuries. Today, you have the option of picking a 25-minute or 1-hour reindeer sleigh ride (approximate timings), which will take you on a journey through the wintery landscape. It will give you the chance to see these animals from a new perspective.

Aurora Hunting in the Wilderness

Using the mobility of a bus to your advantage, your guide will drive you further north to a location determined by the local weather and Aurora forecasts.

Along the way, you will stop and take photos at some scenic locations before travelling to the viewpoint.

Once you reach a prime Northern Lights viewpoint, you will enjoy warm drinks and snacks as you wait in anticipation of a show.

Duration: approximately 3 hours in total

Snowshoe Hike

Snowshoeing allows you to walk over the soft snow with ease and is a brilliant way to connect to the nature around you. During a peaceful hike, you will follow your guide through the wintry forest and to a nearby fell. Here, you will enjoy a hot drink and your guide will tell you more about the flora and fauna in the area. If luck is on your side, you may even see some of the wildlife wandering by.

Duration: approximately 2 hours in total



Cross-County Ski School

Cross-country skiing is a traditional and hugely popular activity in Lapland. You don't need any previous skiing experience as your expert guide will teach you the basics. Then you will all head along the forest trail to see more of the winter landscape as you glide across the snow.

Duration: approximately 2 hours in total



Raekallio Art Gallery Visit

Visit Reijo Raekallio's home gallery to see his wonderfully designed building as well as a varied exhibition.

Raekallio has spent 50 years painting the everyday life of the people, reindeer and nature of this wonderful region and his art brings the beauty of the surroundings to life with atmospheric colours.

You will be transferred to and from the gallery approximately 2km away.

Duration: approximately 1 to 2 hours in total (depending on the group)



Husky Safari (5km)

Husky sledding is one of the most popular Arctic activities and when you try your hand as a musher, you'll soon see why.

When you first meet your team of sled dogs, chances are they will be excitable and barking, eager to get going. Rest assured, as soon as they take to the trail, they will quieten down so you can enjoy the peaceful surroundings.

Husky Safari (10km)

For those who want a little more than a taster of husky sledding, this 10km track is a longer expedition so you can really settle into your role as a musher.

You will usually travel two per sled (one driving and one as a passenger in the sled)

Duration: approximately 2 hours in total (10km or around 1hr sled ride) including short transfers and briefing.



Reindeer Day

Reindeers are synonymous with Lapland and during this activity, you'll gain a wonderful insight into their importance when you meet a reindeer breeder.

You will learn all about reindeer herding and the Sámi culture before jumping into the sleigh and letting these wonderful animals take you on a ride (approximately 1 hour) through the wintry landscape.

There will also be time to feed the reindeer and take photos with them. Drinks and lunch are included.

Duration: approximately 3 hours in total including lunch; sleigh ride lasts approx. one hour.

Snowmobiling and Ice Fishing

Combine two popular Arctic activities during this snowmobiling and ice fishing experience. You will follow your guide on snowmobiles, travelling over fells and through snowy forests until you reach a frozen lake in the wilderness.

Here, your guide will help you drill a hole through the thick ice. Then you'll bait the hook and see who is lucky enough to get the catch of the day.

You will also build a fire and enjoy a light lunch – if you're

lucky enough to catch any fish then this will be served at lunch.

Please note, you will travel two per snowmobile with the option to swap drivers however, you must be at least 18 years old and hold a full driving licence to drive a snowmobile. Children aged 13 and under will travel in a sleigh pulled by the guide's snowmobile. Children who are 13-14 years old and 140cm tall can choose to travel pillion on their parent's snowmobile but will be charged as an adult.

Duration: approximately 4 hours in total including lunch

Snowmobile Safari (4 Hours)

For the ultimate snowmobiling experience, this longer safari takes you further into the wilderness to really appreciate the scale of the snowy environment.

On this journey, you will travel through wintery forests, powdery snowdrifts and admire the breathtaking scenery all around you. Your guide will stop in various places so that you can capture these amazing sights on camera and you will also enjoy hot drinks and a light lunch.

Please note, you will travel two per snowmobile with the option to swap drivers however, you must be at least 18 years old and hold a full driving licence to drive a snowmobile. Children aged 13 and under will travel in a sleigh pulled by the guide's snowmobile. Children who are 13-14 years old and 140cm tall can choose to travel pillion on their parent's snowmobile but will be charged as an adult.

Duration: approximately 4 hours in total including lunch

Snowmobile Safari (2 Hours)

Snowmobiling is a must-do Arctic activity. It is a vital form of transport in these remote locations but offers you an adventurous way to explore the stunning Lappish landscapes.

Along the way, you will stop at scenic locations to take photographs and admire the views and you can warm up with a hot drink and snacks.

Please note, you will travel two per snowmobile with the option to swap drivers however, you must be at least 18 years old and hold a full driving licence to drive a snowmobile. Children aged 13 and under will travel in a sleigh pulled by the guide's snowmobile. Children who are 13-14 years old and 140cm tall can choose to travel pillion on their parent's snowmobile but will be charged as an adult.

Duration: approximately 2 hours in total

Aurora Photography Workshop

Aurora Snowshoeing

Strap on a pair of snowshoes and follow your guide into the quiet forest, where the only sound will be the soft snow beneath your feet. Enjoy a gentle walk into the Arctic night and make your way to a cosy hut where you can warm by the fire with hot drinks and snacks.

The guide will tell stories of the Northern Lights while keeping an eye out for a potential display.

Aurora Hunting by Heated Sleigh

Take a seat in a heated sleigh and enjoy this relaxing way to search for the Northern Lights. Your guide will tow the sleigh away from any light pollution and all the way to the top of a fell for a brilliant viewpoint.

You can keep warm by the fire with snacks and hot drinks while your guide will tell you stories of the Northern Lights. Prepare your camera with the help of your guide and wait for a light show to hopefully appear.

Aurora Hunting by Snowmobile

Travel into the Arctic night as you follow your guide up the snowy fell and to a brilliant location for Northern Lights searching.

Once at the top of the fell, you will warm by the fire and enjoy snacks and hot drinks. Keep an eye on the sky at all times, as the Auroras could start to dance at any moment.

Please note, you will travel two per snowmobile with the option to swap drivers however, you must be at least 18 years old and hold a full driving licence to drive a

snowmobile. Children aged 13 and under will travel in a sleigh pulled by the guide's snowmobile. Children who are 13-14 years old and 140cm tall can choose to travel pillion on their parent's snowmobile but will be charged as an adult.

Levi Northern Lights Village (Nights: 1-3)



Located in the far north of Finland, 16km away from the centre of Levi and close to the ski resort (approx. 14km), the Northern Lights Village sits tucked away in its own piece of wilderness.

With 40 Aurora Cabins, you'll have the brilliant opportunity to view the Northern Lights right from your bed. Each cabin comes equipped with a half-glass roof with the twin or double beds situated underneath. This is one of the few places in the world where you'll prefer a sleepless night!

All cabins are in walking distance of the restaurant which serves local, Lappish delicacies.

Facilities

The village restaurant takes inspiration from the traditional wooden Finnish tipis with Lappish décor.

Using flavours from Lapland and the Barents Sea regions, the restaurant serves local food and special delicacies. Breakfast is a buffet of continental options and some hot dishes. Evening meals are a buffet with starters of soups and salad, and then a choice of local meat or fish will follow. Dietary requirements are all well-catered for as long as we are informed at the time of booking.

All activities start from The Northern Lights Village (except the husky safaris and art gallery) to make your holiday as easy as possible.

Aurora Cabins

Each Aurora Cabin comes equipped with a half-glass roof which all face north, for optimal Northern Lights viewing. What's more, the windows are laser heated to ensure the snow melts and you have a constant view of the Arctic. The designs are based on a traditional wooden kota (tepee) in Finland.

Inside, you'll find twin beds which can be made into a double and there is also a sofa bed (suitable for an additional adult). There is a shower room, toilet and luggage storage area (please note that hot water is limited). You also have tea and coffee making facilities, a hairdryer, minibar and unlimited WiFi.

Cabins are not cleaned between arrival and departure unless requested from reception. Additionally, towels can be exchanged at reception if required.

Levi Northern Lights Village - Aurora Suites



Brand new for winter 2023 and exclusive to Levi Northern Lights Village are the Aurora Suites. There

are 10 in total and still a convenient walking distance to the restaurant and activity meeting point.

The suites are around 44m² and are spacious enough to sleep up to 5 guests. They also include their own sauna. The suites are equipped with air conditioning and heating, a hairdryer, a minibar (charges apply locally), safe and tea and coffee-making facilities.

The glass roofs still have their trademark laser-heated glass to ensure a clear view into the night sky to allow you the ultimate luxury of enjoying a Northern Lights display, snuggled up in bed.

The Specifics

Holiday group size (approximate)
